## 1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules, and as modified within or by the sailing instructions.

1.2 The regatta is designated Category C in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

1.3 All competitors must comply with the DCYRA 2022 Sailing Season Safe and Healthy Sailing Guidelines

## 2 RISK

2.1 All competitors are ultimately responsible for the inherent risks associated with sailboat racing. It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. Each competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

## 3 FLEETS

3.1 Laser Open Fleet – Adults or Juniors racing either standard (full) rigs or radial rigs that can be interchanged throughout the regatta.

3.2 Laser Radial Fleet – Adults or Juniors (sailors who will not be 19 years or older in 2022) sailing with radial or 4.7 rigs that can be interchanged throughout the regatta. The radial fleet may be started with the Open class if entries do not warrant a separate start (See RRS #3).

## 4 FEES

4.1 Required Fees. The entry fee prior to July 8, 2022 is \$50.00. The entry fee after July 8, 2022 is \$70. Checks should be payable to DCYRA. Registration is located at Deep Creek Yacht Club at Turkey Neck

4.2 We are currently not offering a Saturday dinner option as part of the regatta. However, there is going to be Luau at the club on Saturday night with a separate signup and fee. Luau details will be posted on the website and sent out to registrants as soon as the details are finalized.

## 5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1 Saturday, July 9, 2022

9:45: Registration closes

**ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE**

0930: Additional copies of racing instructions will be available on club patio

0945: Skippers meeting will be conducted by the Race Committee on the lower patio in front of the club house

1100: First warning signal, races to follow Schedule of Events (continued) Sunday,

July 10 1000: First warning signal, races to follow Results will be posted ASAP after last racing. Regatta chair will gather winners for photos and awards (following the social distancing protocols that are in place at that time).

5.2 No race shall start after 1430 on Sunday.

5.3 The total number of races will be at the discretion of the race committee.

## 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

## 7 SCORING

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A, shall apply, except as modified by the sailing instructions.

7.2 A minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

## 8 AWARDS

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to:

Open Fleet: At least first through fourth place and first place Great Grand Master

Radial Fleet: At least first through third place

(by Little Sandy's Restaurant :) Turn left onto MD Rte. 135 Turn left onto Turkey Neck Rd. Turn left onto Yacht Club Rd. You'll see the club at the bottom of the hill. \*If you miss the left turn at Sand Flat Rd., you'll end up in Oakland. Stay on MD 219 (road will take a hard left in town, follow the signs to the left, then stay straight as the road turns into MD Rte. 135.
